SUMMER CAMP (Sunday - Saturday)

sleeping Bag (or blankets)	flashlight (extra batteries)
foam pad (or air mattress)	toothbrush and toothpaste
ground cloth	soap
"T"-Shirts (scout related)	shampoo
** Long sleeve shirt (or sweatshirt)	washcloth and towel
jacket	pocket knife
shorts	insect repellent
** long pants	Scout handbook
underwear	3 ft. length of rope
socks	pen, pencil, paper
rain gear	coat hangers
tennis shoes	Pipestone Wood (1 cubic foot)
** hiking boots	spending money (\$10-\$20)

DO NOT BRING: radio (or other electronics), tobacco (any form), fireworks, sheath knife (fixed blade), offensive or otherwise inappropriate clothing.

* NOTE: A COMPLETE UNIFORM MEANS: Long pants or shorts, shirt, socks, belt.

WINTER CAMP (WEEKEND)

Hat, gloves, thermal underwear, rain gear, waterproof boots, adequate coat or jacket.
