TROOP BUGLER

GENERAL INFORMATION

Type: Appointed by the Senior Patrol Leader

Term: 6 months - 1 year

Reports to: Assistant Senior Patrol Leader

Description: The Bugler plays for the troop on campouts and other appropriate functions. Bring your Bugler to all troop meeting and actives.

Comments: To be a good Bugler you need to know all the bugling calls such as Assembly, Call to Quarters, Church, Mess, Drill, First Call, Officers, Fire, Recall, To the Colors, Retreat, Reveille, and Taps. The Bugler should earn Bugling Merit Badge by the end of his service.

QUALIFICATIONS

PERFORMANCE REQUIREMENTS

Training: You must attend the troop Junior Leader Training even if you have attended in the past.

Attendance: You are expected to attend 60% of all troop meetings, Patrol Leaders' Council meetings, outings, and service projects. If your attendance is low, you can be removed from office.

Effort: You are expected to give this job your best effort.

GENERAL LEADERSHIP RESPONSIBILITIES

Uniform: Set the example by wearing your uniform correctly. This means that you will wear all of the parts of the troop uniform, shirttail tucked in, with all required badges in their correct locations.

Behavior: Set the example by living the Scout Oath and Law in your everyday life. Show Scout Spirit in everything you say and do.

Attendance: Set the example by being an active Scout. Be on-time for meetings and activities. You must call the Senior Patrol Leader or Scoutmaster if you are not going to be at a meeting or if you suddenly have to miss an outing. You also need to make sure that someone will assume your responsibilities.

Sounds other chosen song at troop meetings or campouts when requested.

Should earn Bugling Merit Badge by the end of term.
